

**Is God fair to those who haven't heard the gospel, can they know Him without it?**

Questions like this disappear when we believe and know the goodness and love of God

Mar 10:18 ...**No one is good but One, that is God** Ps 145:9 **The Lord is good to all,**

1 Jo 4:8 ...**God is love.** And God's love has made His existence knowable by everyone.

Ps 19:1-3 **The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of**

NIV **His hands. Day after day they pour forth speech; night after night they**

**display knowledge. There is no...language where their voice is not heard.**

But this universal belief that there is a God wont save us from sin, we must be re-born.

Jo 3:7 (Jesus) ...**You must be born again** (our spirits, dead to God, must be re-born)

But how? 1 Pe 1:23 **Having been born again...by the word of God...**

Jam 1:18 ...**He gave us birth by His Word of Truth...** AMP

Eph 1:13 **In Him (Jesus Christ) you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation** (from sin and death to God)...

From whom? Rom 10:13-15 **Whoever calls on the name of the LORD will be saved** (from sin). **How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? How shall they hear without a preacher** (of God's words)?

God's words spoken to me, which I believe in my heart, is how I receive Jesus Christ:

Jer 15:16 **Your words were found, and I ate them** (I believed them), **And Your word was to me the joy and rejoicing of my heart...**

John 6:53 ...**Unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life** (eternal life, the life and nature of God) **in you.**

John 14:6 ...**No one comes to the Father (God) except by Me** (His word).

God's existence is knowable by all, who then begins to know Him? Those who want to:

Matt 5:6 **Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness** (God is our righteousness, and all His words are righteousness), **For they will be filled.**

Ps 34:18 **The LORD is near to those who have a broken heart** (in godly sorrow over sin) **He saves such as have a contrite spirit** (want reconciliation with Him).

How can God reach the unsaved? By visions and Angels to connect them with believers

Acts 10:1-33 **Cornelius...one who feared God** (but was unsaved)...**saw clearly in a vision an angel of God...saying...send men to Joppa...to get...Peter. While Peter thought about** (his own vision) **the Holy Spirit said to him, "Three men are seeking you...go with them, doubting nothing..."** (Cornelius to Peter) **"We are all present before God, to hear all the words commanded you by God."** (There is no partiality with God – what He did for Cornelius He'll do for anyone).
