Rom 6:22 **Now being made free from sin** (self-rule) 1 Pe 4:2 **To live...for the will of God** (ruled by God's Spirit) 2 Co 5:15 ...(In, and) **For Him who died for me...**

Rom 8:2 **Because the rule of the Holy Spirit of life** (as I live permanently) **in Christ** **Jesus has made me free from the rule of sin** (self) **and death** (to God).

What are some of the things that being freed **from** sin I am now free, in Christ, **to** enjoy?

Free to be a follower of Christ and say yes to and do what pleases my heavenly Father.

Free to eat Christ's flesh, His word, and drink His blood, His Spirit, and be made like Him.

John 6:56 **He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood lives in Me, and I in him.**

Free, in and by Him, to impart Christ's nature, to win others to Him and grow them in Him.

Free to be occupied with the interests of others, not just my own, and have time for them.

Free to have God's love alone constrain my will, instead of, common sense, the written word, tradition, religion, and the opinion of others. Free in conscience to do what He says.

1 Co 6:12 **All things are lawful for me...but I wont be brought under the power of any**

Free to live in God's presence, in His provision, health and protection, and to enjoy Him.

2 Cor 1:20 **For all the promises of God in Christ are Yes, and in Christ Amen...**

Free, in and by Him, to: pray answered prayers, thank Him always, and preach His word.

Free, by His own imparted faith to me, to increasingly trust God and as His child obey Him

Jer 7:23 **Obey My voice , and I will be your God...so that it may be well with you.**

Free to grow in revealed knowledge of God, by His humility certain I'm nothing without Him.

Free to be un-offendable, to always forgive, to overlook others' sins, and to keep silent.

Pro 19:11 **Discretion makes one slow to anger; it is his glory to overlook an offence**

Free to be adventuresome, creative, not needing experience, unafraid of making mistakes

Free to smell the roses, not driven by circumstance, discerning God's hand in everything.

1 Tim 6:17 **....But trust in the living God, who gives us richly all things to enjoy.**

Free to be at peace, right with God, happy, and to unashamedly anticipate Christ's return.
