

Can there still be a veil of my human nature partially over my heart?

Hos 10:12 **Sow for yourselves righteousness**(by trusting and obeying God); **Reap in mercy** (His forgiveness); **Break up your fallow ground** (repent of a heart hardened by sin), **For it is time to seek the LORD** (The Lord is the Holy Spirit, He must control your will, thereby removing the veil of your human nature, sense and reason, from denying God access to your heart), **Till He comes and rains righteousness on you** (with the veil removed God can rain His righteous living words, the opposite of sin, into your heart, breaking up the hardness caused by sin, each sin being an act of self-will).

13 **You have plowed wickedness; You have reaped sin. You have eaten the fruit of lies, Because you trusted in your own way...**

Jer 4:3-4 **Break up your fallow ground...Circumcise yourselves to the LORD...**

2 Cor 3:15 **Even to this day, when the Bible is read, a veil** (of their human nature) **lies on their heart.**

16-17 **Nevertheless when one turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away. Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.**

Rom 8:5 **Those who live as their human nature tells them to, have their thoughts controlled by what human nature wants. Those who live as the Spirit tells them to, have their thoughts controlled by what the Spirit wants.** TEV

Is it possible for the veil of my human nature to only partially be removed from my heart?

Can there be an area of my life, such as: money, job, close relatives, sex, pleasure, sports, or my screen time, in which my human nature still holds a firm grip on my will, while other areas of my life are fully yielded to and governed by the Holy Spirit? Yes. The Holy Spirit now occupies my spirit, my spiritual house, but there are still one or more rooms to which I have not yet given over full control, they are veiled. Am I likely to be deceived into thinking I have given full control because I am led by God in most areas? Yes. But every time I move in that one area is it likely to knock me out of Christ?

Heb 3:13 **Exhort one another daily...lest any of you be hardened** (of heart) **through the deceitfulness of sin.**

2 Cor 5:17-18 **If anyone is in Christ** (meaning, right now their will is fully surrendered to and under the control of the Holy Spirit), **they are a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. Now all things are of God** (that is, until I act in an un-surrendered to God, veiled, area of my life, in which case I am no longer in Christ, I am no longer His new creation – very sad)...

Does this contradict the saying “If Christ is not Lord of all He’s not Lord at all”? Yes, even though I’ve used this saying myself, I see now it isn’t true. Christ may very well be Lord of most of my life while not yet Lord of one or more areas. But this divided heart will be in conflict until Christ either becomes Lord of all or He ceases to be Lord at all.
