

The eye – God’s five meanings, including His all seeing eye

Matt 18:9 If your eye causes you to sin, pluck it out and cast it from you. It is better to enter into life with one eye, rather than having two eyes, to be cast into hell fire.

What does God mean by my eye? My natural eye or a person in the body of Christ who is called to be an eye, one who should see spiritually, but leads others into sin, into self-will?

Matt 6:2-3 When you do a charitable deed, do not (seek) glory from men...do not let your left hand (other people) know what your right hand (meaning you) is doing,

1 Cor 12:21 And the eye (a Christian) cannot say to the hand (another Christian), "I have no need of you"; nor again the head to the feet, "I have no need of you."

What does God mean by my eye, my natural eye or the eye of my heart, that is, my spirit?

Isa 11:3 His delight is in the fear of the Lord, He shall not judge by what His (natural) eyes see, Nor make a decision by what his (natural) ears hear; NASU

Eph 1:18 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know...

Matt 13:15 This people’s hearts have become hardened. Their (spiritual) ears are hard of hearing, and they have closed their (spiritual) eyes (they can’t see God).

Eph 4:18 ...Their understanding is darkened...because of the blindness of their heart;

If I’m not yet converted to Christ and so only see with my natural eyes, or I’ve been born again but I walk by natural sight and not by the sight of my spirit, how can this change?

Conversion to Christ: Ezek 36:26 I'll give you a new heart, put a new spirit in you. I'll
MSGE remove the stone heart from your body and replace it with a heart that's God-willed (that sees God – born again) not self-willed (that is spiritually blind to God).

Recovery of spiritual sight: Luke 4:18 The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me to preach (God’s words for the)...recovery of sight to the blind;

Mat 5:8 Blessed are the pure in heart (righteous, saved from sin) for they can see God.

What does God mean by my eye, the “I” of self-rule to be replaced with the “I” of His rule?

Ps 32:8 (God) I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will guide you with My eye (My “I”). Psa 25:12 ...And teach you how you should choose.

Pro 8:12 I am Wisdom, and I have insight; I have knowledge and sound judgment TEV

Gal 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ lives in me

Matt 6:22 The light of the body is the eye: if then your eye is single (the “I” of self has been crucified there remains only God’s “I”) your whole body will be full of light.
