God's will and ability in relationships to: pray for, give thanks for, and to submit to, others

God's perfect words for spouses, which if received have all His divine power to do them

Eph 5:25-26 **Husbands, love your wives (her greatest need), just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, so that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word,**

Eph 5:33 **Let each man of you without exception love his wife as being in a sense his very own self; and let the wife see that she respects her husband (his greatest need)...and loves and admires him exceedingly.** AMP

Matt 7:2 **For with what judgment you judge (your spouse, by appearance and not with righteous judgment that seeks God's will), you will be judged; and with the measure you use, it will be measured back to you (either a short measure that criticizes, or a long measure that forgives and tolerates).**

John 7:24 **Don't judge by appearance but judge with righteous (God's) judgment.**

Jam 1:21 **...Receive with meekness God's implanted words into your heart, for they have the power to save your will from (the) sin (of hasty judgments).**
