

God's promises of protection from harm to those who love Him

If I listen to, that is, discern God's will and by Him do it, He can protect me from Satan

Prov 1:32 **The turning away (from God) of the (willfully) ignorant (who lack God's words in them) will kill them (to God), **And the complacency (casual indifference toward God) of fools will destroy them** (eternally);**

33 **But whoever listens to Me (My sheep hear My voice) will live safely and be secure (spiritually, physically and financially) without fear of evil.**

Prov 12:21 AMP **No actual evil, misfortune, or calamity will come upon the righteous (who obey God), **but the wicked (who don't obey God and therefore belong to Satan) will be filled with evil, misfortune, and calamity (all from Satan, the thief who comes to steal, kill and destroy).****

Prov 19:23 **The fear of the Lord (God's living words and Holy Spirit, Jesus, in our hearts) is life (Christ's life and love for the Father) **and those who have it (Him) live satisfied; They cannot be visited with actual evil.** AMP**

Eccl 8:5 **Those who keep God's commands (to them) will experience nothing harmful; **a wise person's heart** (made wise by God's words and Spirit in their spirit) **discerns both (God's) time and (God's will or) judgment,****

So often God offers to keep me from harm if I will love and obey Him; it's why I'm here

Ps 91:9 **Because you have made the Lord (the Lord is the Holy Spirit and is my Lord when in my spirit)...**the place where you live** (at any moment I live where my soul, my will lives, either in my human nature or in my spirit).**

10 **No evil will befall you, nor any plague come near where you live.**

11 **God will give His angels charge over you to keep you in all your ways.**
