

**Is God fair? Good? Impartial? When it comes to those who haven't yet heard the gospel..**

**Is God fair? YES**

**Prov 16:11** "He sets the standards for fairness." How?

**John 1:9** "The true light who gives light to every person coming into the world."

**John 8:12** "I am the light of the world."

**Prov 20:27** "The spirit of a person is the lamp/light of the Lord."

God in His fairness leveled the playing field for all men to come to Him. How intelligent or unintelligent you are has nothing to do with it. You cannot and never will be able to know God naturally with your brain. It is impossible. God is a spirit and so in His wisdom He gave us a spirit to know Him, eliminating any excuses that you are just not smart enough, you just can't grasp it, or because of status you are not worthy. No person with a high IQ can come to the knowledge of God, but the spirit/heart of a person which He put in every one of us while we were in our mothers womb is fully able and capable of knowing God.

**Is God Good? YES**

**Mar 10:18** "There is only one Good and that is God."

**Ps 145:9** "The Lord is good to all."

**Ps 84:11** "No good thing (including salvation) does He withhold to those who (want, are willing to and do) walk uprightly."

God alone is good, and in His goodness He gave Himself on the cross not only for our sins but the sins of the whole world. **Rom 2:11** "God does not show favoritism."

"He is no respecter of persons."

"He shows no partiality."

**1 Sam 16:7** "For people look at outward appearance but God looks at the heart."
