

God changes people's wills as the righteous pray His revealed will

Pray God's will: We can only know God's will as His Holy Spirit reveals it to our hearts:

1 John 5:14-15 **...If we ask anything according to God's will, He hears us. If we know that God hears us...we know that we have whatever we have asked of Him.**

1 Cor 2:11-12 **...No one knows the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God. Now we have received...the Spirit from God, that we might know His thoughts...**

Pray God's way: Luke 11:8 (Jesus) **...Because of his shameless persistence and insistence, (his unwilling friend) will get up and give him as much as he needs.**

9 (Jesus) **So, ask (God in faith, the same insistent way) and it will be given you;** AMP

Ps 66:18 (But) **If I conceal sin (self-will) in my heart, the Lord will not hear (my prayer).**

Since Satan rules the world God has to find a human being, who has authority on earth, to reveal His will to, so that they can pray and believe for it, allowing God to then fulfill it.

Example: It was God's will to bring Israel back from captivity: Jeremiah 29:10 -11...**After seventy years are completed at Babylon, I will visit you and perform My good word toward you, and cause you to return to this place. I know the thoughts that I think toward you...thoughts of Shalom (your salvation) and not of evil...**

Years later a godly person is led by God to find this scripture and then pray it into fulfillment:

Dan 9:2 **...I Daniel, understood from the scriptures, by the word of the Lord through Jeremiah...that the ruination of Jerusalem would last seventy years.**

3 **Then I turned toward the Lord God to make request by prayer, supplication (insistence) with fasting, sackcloth, and ashes (for its fulfillment – and it was).**

A promise by God to bring revival; that waited for righteous people to pray it into fulfillment

Isa 44:3 **I will pour water (My word) on those who are thirsty, and floods on the dry ground (of hearts); I will pour My Spirit and My blessing on your children;**

Duncan Campbell wrote: "In 1949, some church leaders on the Island of Lewis issued a proclamation...that called the people to consider the low state of vital Christianity in the land...two older women...sisters, one 82, one 84 and blind...had a great heart concern for God to do something and gave themselves in prayer...they insisted on this one promise."

Isa 44:3 **I will pour water (My word) on those who are thirsty, and floods on the dry ground (of hearts); I will pour My Spirit and My blessing on your children;**

And it was fulfilled "The Spirit of the Lord was resting wonderfully on the different towns. His Presence was in the homes of the people, on meadow, moorland, and even on the public roads. This presence of God is the supreme characteristic of a God-sent revival."

Another promise of God for revival that waits for righteous people to pray it into fulfillment:

Isa 43:19 **Behold, I will do a new thing, now it will spring forth; do you not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness and rivers (of My word) in the desert.**
