

## **Salvation of family members – some of God’s examples and His promises**

Noah: Heb 11:7 **By faith Noah, being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with godly fear, prepared an ark for the saving of his household...**

Joshua: Josh 24:15 (Joshua) **...Choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve ...But as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.** (To benefit from such examples we must be taught how the Bible works under the New Covenant, all scripture must be given, spoken, made alive by the Holy Spirit:)

A promise concerning the salvation of family members must be God given, not merely read

Matt 19:11 **Jesus said to them, "All cannot accept this saying, but only those to whom it has been given":** (2 Tim 3:16 All scripture is given by inspiration...)

Rom 7:6 **But now we have been delivered from the law, having died to what we were held by, so that we should serve in the newness of the Spirit** (giving life to God’s words) **and not in the oldness of the letter** (the written word).

1 Co 2:11 **...No one knows God's thoughts except God's Spirit** (and those He speaks to)

A Nobleman: John 4:53 **So the father knew that it was at the same hour in which Jesus said to him, "Your son lives" (that in fact his son was healed). And he himself believed, and his whole household.**

Cornelius a Roman Centurion: Acts 10:2 (Cornelius) **a devout man; one who feared God with all his household, who gave charitably...and prayed to God always.**

Acts 11:13-14 (Cornelius) **told us how he had seen an angel standing in his house, who said to him, 'Send men to Joppa, and call for...Peter, who will tell you words by which you and all your household will be saved.'**

A Philippian Jailer: Acts 16:30-31 **He (the Jailer) brought (Paul and Silas) out and said, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" They said, "Believe on (as touching) the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household."**

32 **Then they spoke the word of the Lord to him and to all who were in his house.**

God’s extended blessing to the children of those who fear Him, who He’s made righteous

Ps 103:17 **The mercy of the LORD is from everlasting to everlasting On those who fear Him, And His righteousness to children's children,**

Prov 20:7 **The righteous person walks in their integrity; their children are blessed after them.**

Jer 32:39 **I will give them one heart and one way, so that they may fear Me forever, for the good of them and their children after them.**

Acts 2:38-39 **Repent and...be washed by the word of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. For the promise is to you and to your children...to as many as the Lord our God will call.**
